

Bishop: Forasmuch as devout and faithful people have taken in hand to build on this ground a House to be dedicated to the glory of God, and in honor of St. Paul the Apostle, to be known as St. Paul's By-the-Sea, wherein the Gospel shall be truly preached, the Sacraments duly administered, and the Service of Prayer and Praise offered in this and coming generations;
